

AMERICA'S NEW HEALTH CARE LAW STOPS INSURANCE COMPANIES FROM CAPPING YOUR COVERAGE

Now the Affordable Care Act protects your family by making insurance companies play by new rules, including:

Lifetime limits BANNED as of September 23, 2010.

Lifetime limits on most benefits are prohibited in any health plan or insurance policy issued or renewed on or after September 23, 2010.

Denying coverage to kids BANNED as of September 23, 2010. Insurance companies are no longer allowed to deny coverage to kids because of pre-existing conditions like asthma or diabetes.

Rate discrimination against women BANNED as of January 1, 2014. Starting January 1, 2014, insurance companies will no longer be able to charge women more than they charge men for the same coverage.

105 million **Americans** <u>like</u> you no longer face lifetime limits on their insurance plans.
